SPEECH LANGUAGE AND HEARING SCIENCES MAJOR

Students must complete at least 25 credits within the SLHS department (Major courses are numbered 2000 level or above). In addition, students must pass all core courses, a W course and complete one of the following elective sequence: Either one Language Disorders course (SLHS 4245/W **OR** SLHS 4254/W) and a Speech Disorders course (SLHS 4251), **OR** two Language Disorders courses (SLHS 4245/W **AND** SLHS 4254/W). For students considering a graduate degree in audiology (i.e., Au.D.), they must take the Speech Disorders course and one Language Disorders course. We strongly recommend that these students take SLHS 4251 **AND** SLHS 4245/W **OR** SLHS 4254/W.
